

# ● Testing the Agenda short keys

Dear Agenda support team, Drew,

I'm a big fan of Agenda, using it a lot.

Allow me to share one issue I encounter that is quite annoying to me: **Format shortcuts not working with international keyboards input sources.**

Note that my MacBook Pro has an Azerty keyboard, the standard lay-out for Belgium and France. It corresponds to following keyboard input sources (in settings): Belgian or French Numerical

## The test

I tested all format short keys. Note that I tested it with keyboard input source set to Belgian an French Numerical.

### 1) Testing Style (through shortcuts)

Body Text  $\text{^}\text{⌘}0$  ❌

- Does not do anything

Heading  $\text{^}\text{⌘}1$  ❌

- Goes to "On the Agenda" instead, (which is supposed to be short key " $\text{^}\text{⌘}1$ ")
- " $\text{^}\text{⌘}1$ " short cut does not do anything

Sub-heading  $\text{^}\text{⌘}2$  ❌

- Goes to "Today" instead, (which is supposed to be short key " $\text{^}\text{⌘}2$ ")
- " $\text{^}\text{⌘}2$ " short cut does not do anything

Minor Heading  $\text{^}\text{⌘}3$  ✅

Minor Sub-Heading  $\text{^}\text{⌘}4$  ✅

Preformatted  $\text{^}\text{⌘}5$  ✅

### 2) Testing Lists

- Bullet List ⌘- ✓
- 1. Numbered List ⌘I ✓
- Checklist ⌘C ✓
- ☑ Mark As Checked ^⌘C ✓

### 3) Testing indentation

Increase ⌘] ✗

- ] key is not present on my keyboard (See Belgian & French Numerical keyboard lay-out)
- Short key does not do anything when using the key corresponding to the ] on a US keyboard.

Decrease ⌘[ ✗

- ] key is not present on my keyboard (See Belgian & French Numerical keyboard lay-out)
- Short key does not do anything when using the key corresponding to the ] on a US keyboard.

### 4) Other Format keys

**Bold** ⌘B ✓

*Italic* ⌘I ✓

Underline ⌘U ✓

Fixed Width ⌘L ✓

~~Strikethrough~~ ⌘X ✓

Superscript ^⌘+ ✓

Subscript ^⌘- ✓

## Conclusion

A small test done with input source US (guessing where the right keys are) work off-

course perfectly, so the issue seems to be that short keys are not taking into account the keyboard lay-out settings (input sources)
